Ernst & Young announces San Diego Entrepreneur of the Year awards

Ernst & Young announced the winners of this year's Entrepreneur of the Year Award in San Diego on Tuesday night, with awards going out to a diverse mix of local entrepreneurs in five categories including consumer and business products, real estate and environmental services, high technology, life sciences and emerging markets.

The San Diego Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year 2007 award winners are: Consumer and Business Products -- Vincent Mudd, president, San Diego Office Interiors; Real Estate and Environmental Services -- **Todd Anson and Steven Black, managing members, Cisterra Partners LLC**; High Technology -- R. Jordan Greenhall, CEO and co-founder, DivX Inc.; Life Sciences -- Tina S. Nova, president and CEO, Genoptix Inc.; Emerging -- Bruce Hansen, chairman and CEO, ID Analytics Inc.; Master Entrepreneur -- Drew Senyei, Enterprise Partners.

All award winners were selected by an independent panel of judges composed of area leaders from business, academic and civic organizations, including Dr. John Robert Beyster, founder of SAIC and the Beyster Institute at the Rady School, UCSD; Jessie J. Knight Jr., executive vice president at Sempra Energy; and Peggy Johnson, executive vice president and president of Qualcomm Internet Services and MediaFLO Technologies Qualcomm Inc.

San Diego award winners are eligible for consideration for the Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year 2007 national program. Award winners in several national categories, as well as the overall national Ernst & Young Entrepreneur Of The Year award winner, will be announced at the annual awards presentation in Palm Springs on Nov. 17. The overall national Entrepreneur of the Year award recipient is then considered for the worldwide event held in Monte Carlo.
